

1. Rev. James Hardyman

In praise to God. This tablet was erected by the members and congregation to the memory of the Rev. James Hardyman. Who for 61 years 1880 -1941 was the faithful minister of this Church.

2. Plomer Family

This tablet is erected to perpetuate the memory of the Plomer family. For many years intimately and honourably connected with this place of worship. Including Thomas Plomer, who died 11th August 1711, aged 40 years. Leaving one son Thomas Plomer, who was the father of Daniel Plomer, from whom descended Mary Ann Gilbert Plomer, the last known member of the family; who during a long life was a consistent, active, and beloved member of this Church: She fell asleep in the faith and hope of the gospel 16th August 1904, Aged 78 years.

3. John Cole, Mary Cole, Samuel Cole

Sacred to the memory of John Cole. Who died March 25th 1845. Aged 83 years. And Mary his wife, who died November 25th 1841 aged 73 years. Also of Samuel Cole. Son of John and Mary Cole. Who died May 25th 1845. Aged 43 years.

4. Maurice Candy

In ever loving memory of my dear husband Maurice Candy. Who departed this life February 1970. Lifes work done. Peace perfect peace.

5. Archibald Baine

In memory of Archibald Baine of North Britain Mercer in this Town whose body is deposited near this place in hopes of a Glorious Refurrection. He departed this life Sept^{re}Y 4th 1730. Ætatis Suæ

6. Boyland and Norman

For services rendered. Clare Boyland 1940 – 1963. Clive Norman 1942 – 1967

7. Three Brothers

In proud and loving memory of three brothers. Sons of Fred and E.J. Jotchan. Who gave their lives for King and Country in France during the Great War 1914 – 1919. Herbert – 21st October 1917. William – Missing since 25th March 1918. Fred – 27th September 1918. They died that others might live.

8. William and Ann Morley

This tablet is erected in loving memory of the best of parents. William Morley (Cheese Factor) of this town, died in the hope of the gospel, on the 28th day of April 1865, aged 59 years. Also of Ann, widow of the above who fell asleep in Jesus, on the 23rd day of May 1870, aged 66 years. "And they shall be mine saith the Lord of Hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels."

9. Elizabeth Spencer

In memory of Elizabeth, the beloved wife of the Rev'd G. S. Spencer, minister of this place, who died November 29th 1874. Also of the above Rev'd G. S. spencer, born May 7th 1803, died January 9th 1894. Waiting for the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ 1 Cor 1. 7

10. Catherine and Benjamin Jones

Sacred to the memory of Catherine Jones the beloved wife of Benjamin Jones of this town who died July 12th 1841 aged 83 years. Also the said Benjamin Jones who died June 7th 1847 aged 86 years. He was many years the respected deacon of this Church and bequeathed L.100 the interest to be laid out in bread and distributed to the poor members of this church during the winter months. For ever.

11. Rev James Hardyman.

Presented to the Rev James Hardyman. In commemoration of 50 years ministry at the Old Town Meeting House, together with a wallet of notes contributed by members of the church and congregation and friends in the town and neighbourhood as a mark of affection and esteem. In remembrance of his faithful services as pastor friend and fellow townsman, during the years 1880 to 1930 inclusive. (Dec 10th 1930).
